Dear Reader,

Our core hours are Monday to Friday 8am - 6:30pm. Any urgent problems outside of these hours need to be directed to NHS 111 who can give advice, arrange a home visit or book an appointment at an out of hours hub.

Our phone lines are open during core hours only, but all online services operate for 24 hours.

We encourage all patients to register for online access which is needed to book online.

Enhanced Access

All GP Primary Care Networks offer some appointments after 6:30pm and on Saturdays. These are for all members of our team (HCAs, nurses, pharmacists, physiotherapists and doctors) and are pre-bookable by calling reception or booking online.

The West Merton Primary Care Network comprises of two practices, Lambton Road Medical Centre and Francis Grove Surgery. We offer slots from 7:30am weekday mornings and now offer slots from 9:00am - 5:00pm on Saturdays.

All PCN patients can use these slots, which are face-to-face by default, but can be changed to telephone slots on request. We also host an additional FCP (First Contact Practitioner) clinic each Saturday afternoon and some additional cervical screening clinics. Our FCP colleagues our senior physiotherapists and can see all joint/back problems and sports injuries. They can arrange x-rays and scans and refer to secondary care colleagues. These slots are available to book online.

On Sundays (pre 8am/post 5pm on Saturdays), our staff are still able to book Merton Hub appointments.

A&E / Casualty should be used only for life threatening conditions (e.g. possible heart attack, stroke, heavy bleeding, shortness of breath or broken bones).

COVID Spring Booster

We will be delivering a Spring Booster to those in Care Homes from early April. All those over 75 or Immunosuppressed will be invited to book an appointment at Merton clinics, which will restart in mid April. We anticipate a more extensive Autumn Booster campaign later in the year.

Cancer Screening

Cancer screening saves lives. Please do NOT overlook your invite to the cervical, bowel and breast screening programmes when invited.

Our cervical screening slots are now online and available to book when you receive your invite with a direct link.

We have introduced additional Saturday smear clinics at Lambton Road.

All women over 25 will be invited every 3 years and all over 50 every 5 years up to age 65.


Targeted Lung Health Checks Programme

The lung cancer early diagnosis service is now live across Merton and Wandsworth.

Patients aged 55 - 74 with any history of smoking will be offered a lung health check with the specialist team at Royal Brompton Hospital and a low dose CT scan if required.

This new service service will save lives and help earlier diagnosis, and treatment of other lung conditions.

PCN Clinics

One of the advantages of a 'Primary Care Network' is that we can develop in-house clinics.

Our in-house Dermatology clinics (run by Dr Matt French) are very popular and save long waits for secondary care slots.

We have recently introduced a new menopause clinic which runs fortnightly at Lambton Road with Dr Alpa Patel. This clinic is suitable for women seeking advice on starting HRT or encountering problems with their current treatment.

We are collaborating with Paediatricians at St Georges to launch a monthly paediatric clinic at Lambton Road.

HRT Pre-payment Certificate

Hormone replacement therapy (HRT) pre-payment certificates (HRT PPC) will be available from April 1st 2023.

Patients who are not exempt from prescription charges will be able to purchase a certificate from the NHSBSA website or in person at a pharmacy registered to sell PPCs.

The HRT PPC will enable patients to access a year's worth of menopause prescription items for the cost of 2 single prescription charges. Please note that some HRT medication is not covered by this scheme.

Some women may find it cheaper to book an annual prepayment certificate that covers all medication, if they are not solely taking HRT. Your community pharmacist can advise you.
